Climate change and the sustainability crisis are existential threats for Europe and the World. We need an ecological and social turnaround! With the European Green Deal the EU member states are committed to turning the EU into a climate neutral continent by 2050 and to implement the Agenda 2030 and its 17 Goals for Sustainable Development. However, to bring these concepts into action politicians need to listen to youth voices.

At the summit young people from Austria, Czech Republic, Germany and Hungary have an opportunity to present and further discuss their point of view on the current situation we are facing with the climate crisis. During the previous events they had an opportunity to reflect on the issues and political processes and formulated demands that political representatives should have in mind to create sustainable and inclusive future for all. With creative and participatory methods they elaborated a Youth Declaration which they will present to the political representatives and public and discuss it with them during the summit in Brno.
