- Improving equitable access to vocational training in solar energy
- Improve the quality of vocational training in solar energy
- Improve the employability of trainees

TARGET GROUPS & PARTNERS

- **Target groups:** Students and all actors in the solar sector
- **Partners:** Technical high schools, Trainers' School, solar companies, ministries in charge of education and technical training.

RESULTS

- 350 graduates
- Over 300 company employees trained
- Capacity building for all teachers on the BEP curriculum
